The Director of CHESME, Professor of Health Economics, Lycourgos Liaropoulos is also the Director of the Sector of Public Health. He has also published widely in international peer-reviewed scientific journals and collective volumes and has coordinated national and international research projects. Since 1994 Prof. Liaropoulos is the National Representative of the Greek Ministry of Health to the OECD Health Committee. he has also serves as a member of other international organizations, such as the Cochrane Collaboration, the International Hospital Federation-IHF, the International Health Policy Forum-IHPF etc.

HISTORY

The Center for Health Services Management and Evaluation, Department of Nursing, University of Athens was founded in August 1996. It evolved from the Institute for Health Systems Management (IMOSY), a non-profit research, policy analysis and training institution, founded in 1989 by an academic team from the Faculty of Nursing. Dr. L. Liaropoulos, Professor of Health Economics, directs CHESME. CHESME specializes in the areas of Health Economics, Health Services Research and Health Care Management. The principal scientific team consists of academics from the fields of Health Economics, Health Informatics and Medicine.
